For use in applications to graduate
programs

September 2026

Overview

For applications to graduate programs, transcripts showing the grades and credentials achieved by the applicant are required.

All transcripts provided by applicants are considered unofficial. Transcripts are only considered official if sent directly by the issuing institution to the University of Calgary. For most programs, only unofficial transcripts are required at the time of application.

Applicants can provide scans of their own copies of official transcripts for their application. These would still be considered unofficial, as they are provided by the applicant.



Requirements

- Student name
- Institution name
- All credentials awarded, courses taken and grades received to date
 - No in-progress courses unless it is the present term
 - All credentials listed either actively in progress, awarded or withdrawn
- **For international transcripts:** transcripts must show credential awarded or degree certificate must be attached
- **For non-English transcripts from non-Canadian institutions:** a certified translation must be attached. Both the original-language documents and translations must be submitted

Preferred elements

- Birth date of student
 - Print date of transcript
 - Page numbers
 - Grading scale of institution
- 

Unacceptable

- Cropped or altered transcripts or screenshots
 - If your transcript is on a webpage, **print to PDF** to capture the entirety of the transcript
- Third-party evaluations
 - We do not accept third-party evaluations in lieu of transcripts
- Provisional results
 - Transcripts must show **final grades** attained
- Out-of-date transcripts
 - Transcripts for in-progress credentials that are printed or issued more than 6 months from the application submission date are considered obsolete
