

Tuition & Fees

Understanding Graduate Student Registration

- All graduate students must maintain continuous registration year-round.
- You are responsible for registering every year.
- Tuition fees are calculated based on the courses you take.
- All students must pay general fees — even when you are not taking courses!

Fee Payment Deadlines

- You are responsible for ensuring your fees are paid by each term's fee payment deadline.
- Check the Academic Schedule in the Graduate Calendar for important dates and deadlines.
- Your program may have tuition fees that are different from regular graduate program fees. Check the Program Specific Tuition Fees table in the Graduate Calendar.

- International Funds Transfer — Western Union GlobalPay for Students
- In-person at Enrolment Services, MB 117
 - Debit (Canadian financial institutions only)
 - Cheque, money order, or bank draft

Funding

Graduate Assistantships

- Some programs offer graduate assistantships to course-based students.
- Ask your graduate program for more information.

Scholarships

- Certain scholarships and awards are open to course-based graduate students.
- Use the online Graduate Awards Database to find scholarships for which you are eligible: grad.ucalgary.ca/awards.

Working

- Consider applying for a Transformative Talent Internship through My GradSkills to gain work experience in your field of study.
- If you are an international student, go to International Student Services (MSC 275) to find out if you are eligible to work in Canada.
